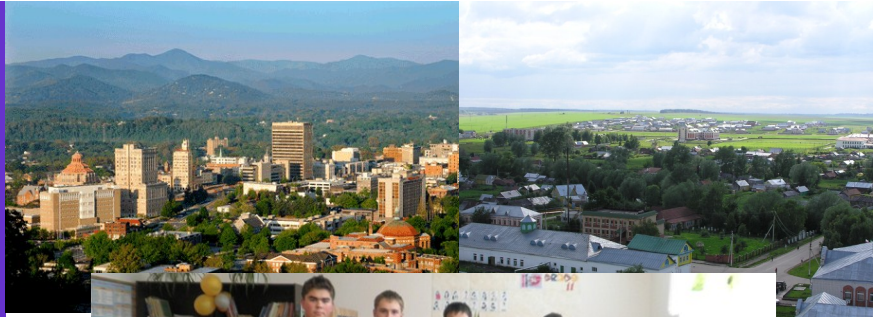


Build bridges instead of walls and you will have a friend

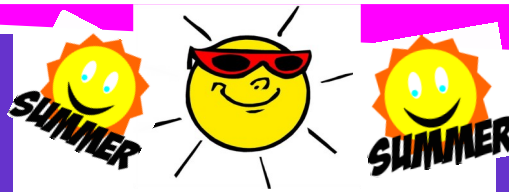
Every evening I went for a walk with my friends.
